Total Points	Benefit Amount
0-50 points	\$300.00 \$150.00 if client lives in Public Housing and only pays utility "overage"
55-75 points	\$450.00 \$225.00 if client lives in Public Housing and only pays utility "overage"
80-105 points	\$600.00 \$300.00 if client lives in Public Housing and only pays utility "overage"
